- Johnson informed the Board that a vote will take place soon to elect a new Director to the Board as pro tem for the remainder of the term of Tracy Knudsen.
- Kressler reviewed the MTA's financials, comparing actual with budget, and updated the Board regarding CMT enrollments, revenues and expenses. Kressler also informed the Board that the MTA's primary bank is changing and that certain investments are also changing to a new fiduciary, which will increase access to banking services, streamline management's oversight of banking accounts and investments, and reduce costs. Furthermore, Kressler informed the Board that changes in technology providers are also being made and that related expenses will not increase.
- Scott reported that Pearson has initiated a discussion with Wiley regarding the possibility of using the *Technical Analysis*, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition textbook by Kirkpatrick and Dahlquist for the CMT exams and to further align the CMT curriculum with the MTA Educational Foundation's college study guide curriculum. Further details regarding the progress of these discussions are forthcoming in the weeks ahead. Board members and Gordon discussed the content of the CMT curriculum, the cost of the exams, and the capability of the CMT Test and Curriculum Committee to implement changes to the curriculum and the timing of such changes.
- Kressler noted that the MTAEF is meeting in New York in early September to discuss long range planning and that several MTA Board members will be in attendance.
