

MAINTAIN YOUR CHARTERHOLDER STATUS

Once you become a <u>CMT charterholder</u>, you will need to:

- Review the <u>Constitution</u> (PDF) and <u>Bylaws</u> (PDF)
- View the Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct
- Submit a <u>Professional Conduct Statement</u> at least annually
- Renew your membership annually

Failure to comply with CMT Association conditions, requirements, policies, and procedures can result in disciplinary sanctions, including suspension or revocation of the right to use the CMT designation.
